Relief Measures

- 25 free kitchen centers have been opened covering 6000 beneficiaries
- 800 food packets has been air dropped in Niyamagiri area on 19.07.2017
- Dry food – 20000 pkts, Saree-10000 Nos., Dhoti-2000 Nos., Mosquito net -1000 Nos., Towel-5000 Nos., Utensil set – 50 Nos., Polythene-5000 pcs, Blanket-1000 Nos. have been distributed
- Q.179.55 Rice, Q.28.728 Dal, Q.71.30 Chuda, Q.13.60 Gud, 170 Boxes Biscuit, 4120 nos. Candle, 8400 nos. Match box have been provided.

- 6 Medical Relief Center opened
- 1580 ORS packets and 20000 Halogen tablets distributed
- Medicines, bleaching power, halogen tablets, saline, ORS, antisnake venoms have been mobilized
- ORS and Halogen Tabs. supplied to ITDA residential schools
