Floods and Heavy Rain 2006

Time – 07.07.06 At 11.30 Hrs.

Cause – Heavy rain due to low pressure in Bay of Bengal from 01.07.2006 to 03.07.2006

Roads Damaged-

- ü Traffic in Adagaon- Bolangir road had been disrupted due to overflow of flood water at Kurala cause way. Now the communication has been restored.
- ü Communication on Paralakhemundi-Kashinagar road blocked at Guma nallah / Kidigaon has been restored.
- ü 5ft. height flood water flowing over the Hati Bridge. Road cut off. Now traffic restored.
- ü Pipalnalla bridge on Bhawanipatana-Kesinga Road is severely damaged. Communication restored.
- ü Sanduala bridge, Kutei bridge on Chatigula - Narla - Rampur road damaged partially. Communication restored.
- ü Karsara Bridge near Kotgarh block washed away. Communication to 5 villages disrupted.

- ü Balandapada - Pairaju road is damaged at 1/800km,3/300km and 5/400km.
- ü Landslide with heavy stone and boulders due to heavy rain blocked the Parvatipur - Laxmipur road. Traffic dislocated from 1st July to 3rd July. Traffic restored.
- ü Vented causeway with its floor protection at 29/400 Km. of Sanasourapalli - Phulkona road severely damaged. Traffic dislocated from 1st July to 3rd July.
- ü Flood water of Mahanadi has marooned the road from Rasanga to Chhamundia under Gania Block. Communication disrupted.
- ü Rayagada to Koraput Railway line has been blocked due to landslide.
- ü Rayagada-Berhampur State Highway had been blocked at Kailashpur due to landslide, but now cleared.
- ü Rayagada - Koraput State Highway has been blocked at Guma due to landslide. Work is going on to clear the road by P.W.D. ODRAF unit with machineries have been engaged.
- ü BT surface bridges damaged with breaches and scours at 102/2km of Koraput-Laxmipur-Raygada-Gunupur. Three spans have been washed away of Sankesh II Bridge.
- ü Rayagada-Berhampur State High way has been cleared for traffic.
- ü The road at Kapasira village towards Kantamal and from Badachhapapalli towards Ghantapada have been submerged and communication disrupted & new communication restored.

Relief Measures-

- Ø 2 ODRAF units deployed in Ganjam and Bolangir Districts for relief and rescue operation
- Ø 9392 Persons were evacuated to safer place
- Ø 52 nos. of relief camp opened. (Bolangir-19, Gajapati-15, Kandhamal-1, Rayagada-8, Subaranpur-9).
- Ø 6559 persons provided with cooked foods.
- Ø 52 nos. of boats deployed for relief and rescue operation
- Ø Dry food in shape of chuda and gur have been provided to the affected people.
- Ø Food Assistance provided wherever needed.
- Ø House damage enumeration is going on. House Building Assistance will be disbursed within 15 days.
- Ø Ex-gratia assistance is being paid to the NoK of the victims.
- Ø Health Teams deployed for medical assistance
- Ø Disinfection of Drinking water sources in the affected area has been started.
- Ø Communication restoration work is in full swing.

Latest Water Level

- Ø Water has been receded from all the affected areas.
- Ø Water level in Mahanadi system is also receding.
